### Show Rules:

1. These shows are governed by the latest ARBA and NARBC show rules. The show committee will have final authority on any interpretations necessary at the shows. The filing of the entry form indicates acceptance of these rules, as well as additional rules listed below.
2. The Mid America Angora Club, Upper Midwest Angora Club, NARBC, Inc , Cedar Rapids RBA and ARBA will not be responsible for any loss or injury by fire, accident, theft or providential destruction. Reasonable precaution will be taken to prevent injury or loss in the showroom.
3. Show officials have the right to add, delete, or reassign judges as circumstances require. The show committee reserves the right to assign breeds to judges.
4. All animals must be permanently earmarked in the left ear. Any animal NOT legibly earmarked will be automatically disqualified.
5. Cooping will not be provided. This is a carrier show. Each exhibitor must furnish his/her own feed and food containers for his/her rabbits.
6. The National Angora Rabbit Breeders Club, Inc Specialty Show mail in deadline is **April 8, 2020** and the online deadline is **April 14, 2020**. The Cedar Rapids RBA is a day of show entry. The fees are listed in this show catalog.
7. Substitutions shall be allowed only in the same sex, class, variety, group, and breed. Substitutions must be made for the National Angora Rabbit Breeders Club, Inc. Show prior to 8:00 a.m. Sunday morning, April 17<sup>th</sup>. There is no additional fee for substitution changes.
8. **LATE ENTRIES** will be accepted for the National Angora Rabbit Breeders Club, Inc Specialty Show. Late entry fees for the National Angora Rabbit Breeders Club, Inc Specialty Show will be: \$9.00 per rabbit and \$5.00 for wool class.
9. **Entry forms** must be completely filled out and submitted with payment for the MAAC for the Specialty Show.
10. Wool entries must be entered in class judging.
11. No breeding will be permitted in the show building unless owners are present.
12. All rabbits open and youth must be carried to the judging table by the owner. Youth exhibitors must carry youth rabbits to the table. It is the owner's responsibility to arrange for someone to carry their rabbits to the judging table if he/she is unable to do so.
13. Sanctioned Breeds for Open and Youth: English, French, Giant and Satin Angoras. Unrecognized varieties may be judged, however they may not compete for legs or awards.
14. Awards will be given after the NARBC, Inc Specialty Show on Sunday, April 19, 2020.
15. **ONLY animals allowed in the showroom are rabbits.** Only Service dogs are allowed in the showroom to assist the disabled.
16. Rabbits will be allowed to leave as soon as judging for the show is completed.
17. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children. Parents must control their children's behavior or will be asked to leave at once. If you are asked to leave, all entry fees will be forfeited.
18. Exhibitors will not be allowed on the side of the show table designated for the judges.
19. Exhibitors must place their rabbits on the judging table PROMPTLY when classes are called.
20. **Entry fees and banquet fees are non-refundable.** There are no refunds for entries not shown.
21. ANY rabbit(s) showing signs of colds or any other ailment will be removed from the showroom.
22. Sweepstakes will be governed by the latest sweepstakes rules of NARBC, Inc.
23. No smoking is permitted inside the show building.
24. The showroom will be unlocked and locked promptly at the times specified in this show catalog.
25. A \$30.00 fee will be assessed for insufficient checks.
26. It is against the ARBA rules to enter the same rabbit in both youth and open classes in the same show. Youth may make entries in both Open and Youth classes with different animals. Adults cannot show in youth classes at any time.
27. **Exhibitors may watch the judging, however, they may not talk to or question the judge(s) during judging.**
28. Come to Iowa and have a GREAT time!

## Official WSG Rules & Sweepstakes, National Angora Rabbit Breeders Club, Inc.

- Check-in entries will be taken at the NARBC Booth/Table, FRIDAY April 17, 2020 from 4 pm to 7 pm, and on SATURDAY, April 18, 2020 from 7a.m. to 8:30 a.m. at which time entries will be closed. If you cannot make it during these times or unable to attend the National Show, you may still mail your entries. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Mail-in entries will be accepted. Postmarked by April 10, 2020. Send to: Emily Ashton, 7733 State Rte 203, Prospect, OH 43342. Be sure to include your name, address, phone number and/or email, entry forms and entry fee (make check payable to hosting club). Be sure to include return postage, for mailed items, if you want the item(s) returned.
- Entry fee is \$5 (US dollars) per item payable to NARBC.
- The following number system must be used to number entries. This will ensure the exhibitors can match up the sheet to the item should they be separated. Example: If Exhibitor #9 enters 10 items of wool for Class A1 then the label on the item should be: Exhibitor # 9, Class: A1, Item Number: 1/10 (indicating this is 1 of 10 items in the class entered by that exhibitor). This MUST be entered on the label on the items as well as on the judging sheet. If the exhibitor only enters one item in the class then it would be: Exhibitor #8, Class: A1, Item Number: 1/1. The judging sheets may then be placed back in the bag or placed in an envelope with the exhibitor number. (The envelope is similar to ARBA Convention checkout envelope).
- Judging will be on SATURDAY APRIL 18, 2020 starting at 9 am. The Show committee reserves the right to adjust the judging date/time however, entry deadline remains the same.
- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor(s). Youth Entries are reserved for ages 18 and younger.
- Judging location will be posted in the booth. Interested persons are welcome to watch the judging, but are instructed not to talk to, or question judge(s) during judging.
- After judging, wool, skeins, and garments, will be released unless other arrangements are made. Checkout procedures must be followed by all exhibitors. Exhibitors are to collect their items, verify with show staff, and sign entry form upon receipt of all items returned. Items are welcome to remain on display but NARBC is not responsible for theft, damage, or return of items unless return postage is paid in advance. Entries which have had return postage paid will be postmarked within 7 days after the conclusion of the contest and will be stored securely. Winning items are encouraged to be displayed at the exhibitor's consent (initial entry form).
- The Fiber Committee will make every effort to display and care for the items entered, but assumes no responsibility for loss or damage. If you would like your item covered, please provide a garment bag, container, etc. \*Please note birds occasionally are present in buildings.
- Absolutely no identifiers may be attached to entries (i.e. name, business card) and no prices may be attached. No photos of animals. These will disqualify an entry.
- All entries are to be unscented. Perfumed and scented entries will be disqualified.
- Entries must make the minimum weight posted. Underweight entries will be disqualified.
- Entries must be picked up no later than Sunday April 19, 2020 at noon. If no return postage was provided and the item is not picked up it becomes the property of NARBC.
- Results will be announced at the banquet and posted in the booth, reported in the newsletter, and posted on the club website(s).

### **Raw Wool Contest Rules-**

- Weight of wool is to be at least 1/4 oz excluding packaging. Samples under 1/4 ounce will be disqualified. There is no maximum.
- Spinner's Sample Wool (1/4 ounce) should be presented neatly lined up and placed in tissue paper then inserted into a clear, gallon size zipped bag. Whole Fleeces are to be placed loosely in a large clear zipped bag as removed from the animal. Fleece should be skirted and presented clean and free of vegetable matter. The fleece should contain only prime wool and not include legs, feet, tail or belly wool. No demerits for wool that needs to be folded into the bag. Points are given for clean, neat presentation. No color restrictions. White and colored wool are to be judged together.

- English, French, Giant, and Satin Angoras are four separate breeds and must be judged separately from each other according to the ARBA Standard of Perfection (excluding color restrictions).
- Wool may be plucked or clipped, with no preference to either.
- Classes as follows:  
A. English, B. French, C. Giant, D. Satin  
    1. Spinner's Sample and 2. Fleece

### **Skein Contest Rules –**

- Weight of skein is to be at least 1 oz., except for class A-1, which is to be at least ½ oz. Underweight skeins will be disqualified.
- All skeins must be handspun and be tied in at least 2 places
- Classes as follows:
  - 100% Angora- white or natural color
    - \_\_\_ 1. Singles, fine and even as possible
    - \_\_\_ 2. Two-ply, fine, medium or bulky
    - \_\_\_ 3. Other ply or novelty
  - 100% Angora- dyed
    - \_\_\_ 1. Single-ply: fine and even as possible
    - \_\_\_ 2. Two-ply, fine, medium or bulky
    - \_\_\_ 3. Other ply or novelty
  - Blended Angora (must be at least 50%)-natural or dyed
    - \_\_\_ 1. Singles, fine and even as possible
    - \_\_\_ 2. Two-ply, fine, medium or bulky
    - \_\_\_ 3. Other ply or novelty
  - Angora plied with other fiber (must be 50% Angora, may use commercial yarn for plying)
    - \_\_\_ 1. Two or more ply
    - \_\_\_ 2. Go Wild!
- \_\_\_ Novice spinner-spinning 1 year or less, or under 16 years of age. AnythingGoes!

### **Garment Contest Rules –**

- All entries must be at least 50% Angora, except where noted (Woven/Felted/Novelty/Cottage).
- If an item is made by more than one person, it should be entered in all persons' names.

  - Large wearable (sweater, vest, shawl, etc.)
