WSG RULES & INFORMATION

1. Check-in entries will be taken at the NARBC WSG booth, November 15, 2025 from 10am to 4pm, at which time entries will be closed. **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

2. Entry fees are to be paid at the time of entry. Entry fee is \$5.00 per item. The following forms of payment are accepted: Cash, Check payable to NARBC, or PayPal (NARBC@yahoo.com)
3. Judging will take place on November 17, 2025, starting at 9:00 a.m. Location of Judging will be posted in the NARBC WSG booth at Convention. The host committee reserves the right to adjust the judging date/time; however, the entry deadline remains the same.
4. All wool, skeins, and garments will be released on November 18, 2025, between 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM Checkout procedures must be followed by all exhibitors. Exhibitors are to collect their items, verify with the host WSG committee chair, and sign the entry form upon receipt of all items returned. NARBC, ARBA, and the host committees are not responsible for theft or damage during the 2025 ARBA Convention.
